## PACKING LIST - Feb. 2018

**YOU MUST BE PAID IN FULL TO GET ON THE BUS ON

### **Your Luggage & Garment Bag (Marching Uniforms/ Concert Attire/Robes)**

- Must be brought to the WOHS Choir Room between 3:00-6:00pm on Tuesday, February 13, 2018. **No exceptions.**
- You must check in one carry-on bag into the choir room on Wednesday, February 14 between 7:00-7:25 am. **No exceptions.**

### **What to bring: In General**

- Clothing for cool or warm conditions
- Comfortable sneakers – maybe 2 pairs, plus socks NOTE: It is not recommended that you wear flip flops in the parks, you will be doing a lot of walking and it will be uncomfortable.
- Sweatshirt/ jacket in case it is cold
- Rain gear / coat
- Sunblock / sunglasses
- Sleepwear

### **Toiletries**

- shampoo, deodorant, soap, toothbrush & paste, etc (travel size if possible)
- Band-aids, small first aid things, just in case. Any personal medication.

### **The Bus & Your Carry-On**

One carry on luggage per student. There are a few items you might want in your carry-on, since we will stop Wednesday evening and also again Thursday morning before arriving in Florida

- Toothbrush & paste, deodorant, change of clothes, contact solution / bed time things
- Pillow / blanket / pajamas / sweats for the bus
- Snacks / water
- Books / Ipod / things to keep you entertained (WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR VALUABLES IF YOU LOSE THEM.)
- HEADPHONES
- Also carry-on: any flutes, oboes, clarinets, alto saxes, bassoons, and trumpets.
- Carry on marching band uniforms/garment bags/shako boxes.

### **Personal Things**

- Bring money (you will need a bit for a few meals/souvenirs)
- Camera

- Cell phone & charger
- Tote bag/drawstring bag if you want to carry stuff in the parks
- Water, snacks, things for the room at night
- **Do Not** bring anything valuable.... laptops, gaming systems (we are not responsible)

### **Symphonic Band Performance-Clinic**

- Make sure you have your music, instrument, mouthpiece, reeds, mallets, sticks, etc for the performance.
- Attire for our clinic is casual. Please no sweatpants/ hoodies.

### **Marching Band Performance**

- Full uniform. This includes uniform, shako, BLACK SOCKS, gloves, plume. If you need gloves bring \$3.00.
- **GIRLS:** bring hair ties, bobby pins, hair spray, or hair gel. No messy hair, no jewelry
- Marching Band raincoats.
- Make sure you have your music, instrument, mouthpiece, reeds, mallets, sticks, etc for the performance.

### **Room Checks**

- Lights out MEANS LIGHTS OUT. No ordering pizza or other shenanigans.
