

Student Code of Conduct

- I/we understand there will be a mandatory luggage check before departure on Wednesday morning, February 14, 2018. In the event that any drug or alcohol items are found, the student will not be allowed to participate in the trip and the student will be subject to all established school protocols related to such.
- All rules and regulations observed by West Orange High School are applicable for the duration of the trip, and my child will be held fully accountable for his/her behavior.
- No one will be allowed to leave the hotel grounds. All students will attend all activities as outlined on the itinerary, no exceptions.
- No one will be allowed to have visitors who are not participants of the trip.
- My child and I will be responsible for any damage done to busses, rooms, and/or other property pertaining to their being part of this trip.
- Any necessary medication must be listed in the Medical Information section of this Florida Registration application. Instructions for administering the medication must be in writing and signed by the parents/guardians.
- I/we will be responsible for all medical bills incurred for my son/daughter.
- Students may visit each other in their rooms at designated times and with the door open at all times.
- I understand that my child and I will be held accountable for any violation of local, state, and/or federal laws (alcohol, substance abuse, etc).
- Unsatisfactory behavior (as determined by the directors) may result in my child not being permitted to participate in student co-curricular activities for the remainder of the school year such as the prom, clubs, music activities, athletics, etc. I further understand that if it is deemed necessary to send my child home, I shall be responsible for picking up my child or purchasing the plane, bus, or train ticket home and will meet my child upon his/her arrival.
- Directors have my permission to take whatever supervisory measures are deemed necessary in order to protect the health and/or safety of my child and other participants of the trip.

In addition, students are expected to adhere to all policies outlined in the Student Handbook, including:

- Only students authorized to participate in a field trip may be in attendance at the event location.
- Students are expected to follow staff directives at all times; anywhere in school, on school grounds, at all school events including field trips, social events, and athletic events.
