Where: Everyone meet at the HS at 10:00am
When: Sunday, March 11

You will be bussed from the HS to the parade, and back. We will meet at the HS at 10:00am in half uniform (pants, black socks, marching shoes, black shirt). Please arrive at the HS early to be sure you have all the necessary items. We will have a short practice that morning. We will return to the HS sometime in the early afternoon, depending on the length and timeliness of the parade. **Check the weather that morning to be sure that you are dressed appropriately!**

Uniform Return Information

ALL uniforms will be collected on Thursday, April 19 from 6:00-8:00pm in the Band Room.

Marching band uniforms must be returned in dry cleaning bags with the tags attached. The following items should be returned: uniform top, uniform bottom, raincoat, garment bag, plume. (Please note that only the top and bottom are required to be dry cleaned.)

Winter Color Guard uniforms must be machine washed. All pieces to the costume must be returned, including if you were issued a garment bag. (Your return date will be 4/26)

Indoor Percussion Ensemble does not have to return items this season.

Jazz and Wind Ensemble tuxedos will be collected at a later date once all performances have concluded.

If you do not return your uniform on time, all grades, report cards, and diplomas will be withheld. Please take care of business!
